Approaches to understand brain function in laboratory animals and to treat brain disease in patients have little in common: molecular neuroscience tools turn specific neurons on or off, while psychiatric medications modulate the flow of information through neural circuits—a difference akin to a building’s main circuit breaker and a dimmer switch. While today’s neuroscience tools have driven progress in understanding the structure-function relationship of the brain, they have not advanced the treatment of human patients.
